Call to Order

Mayor Reed called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilmembers present were John Taylor, Claire Williams, Richard Schmidt and Don Hayes. Councilmember absent was Faye Godwin. Mayor Reed declared that a quorum was present. Also present was the City Attorney Mr. Lindsey. Mayor Reed led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda

A motion was made by Mr. Taylor, seconded by Mr. Schmidt, and unanimously adopted to approve the agenda for the meeting.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Mr. Hayes to approve the minutes from the regular meeting of June 4, 2013 and Ms. Williams seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

1. Item 13-638: Set qualifying dates for November 5, 2013 General Election.
City Clerk Cindy Hanson suggested the dates of August 28, 2013 through August 30, 2013 as the qualifying dates. Mr. Schmidt made a motion to approve the dates and Mr. Taylor seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Item 13-639: Memorandum of Understanding for the Continuation of Community Brickworks Agreement to July 31, 2014.
Ms. Williams made a motion to approve the MOU with Community Brickworks. Mr. Hayes seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comments

Resident Alan Merrill spoke about the significance of the Fourth of July as a holiday of freedom and a time to remind ourselves that we are all working for the greater good.

Mayor and Council Comments

Mr. Taylor thanked Judy Henderson for the work she does through Community Brickworks. He also spoke regarding the Fourth of July celebration and the possibility of canceling due to weather.

Staff Reports

Police Chief Rook presented a Certificate of Commendation and congratulations for a job well done to Corporal Lipham and Officer Downs for the rapid arrest of suspects in an attempted break-in.

Fire Chief Lyle presented the annual statistics to date and gave an update on the progress converting the donated hummer to an off-road wild fire vehicle. He encouraged anyone interested in being a volunteer fire fighter to call him.

Kyle Jones announced the Public Hearings to discuss the millage rate would be July 16th and July 23rd at 5:00 p.m., and the millage rate will be adopted on August 6, 2013 at the regular meeting of the City Council.

Mr. Hayes asked Chief Rook for an update on the tower. Chief Rook answered that he is waiting for mobile communications to obtain the FCC license required.

Adjourn Meeting

Mr. Schmidt made a motion to adjourn and Mr. Hayes seconded. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
