Kyle Jones thanked Maribeth and Ted Wansley for all of the work they are doing at Cochran Mill Park.



# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CHATTAHOOCHEE HILLS ZONING ORDINANCE, SO AS TO REVISE ARTICLE 28 REGARDING THE NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF CHANGES TO THE ZONING MAP AND CHANGES TO THE TEXT OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Chattahoochee Hills Zoning Ordinance regulates standards and procedures for the modification of the zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Chattahoochee Hills City Council updates zoning regulations for the use of property as well as standards and criteria related thereto throughout the City of Chattahoochee Hills consistent with the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Chattahoochee Hills City Council find there is a need to clarify, update and strengthen the zoning regulations and criteria in order to adequately protect and further the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Chattahoochee Hills City Council find the need to initiate changes to the Zoning Map and to the text of the Zoning Ordinance in an efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the following regulations will address these issues and further the public health, safety and welfare;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTAHOOCHEE HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS that:

**Section 1:** Subsection (b) of Section 28.3 (Public Hearing and Notice Requirements) of Article 28 of the City of Chattahoochee Hills Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended so as to delete said paragraphs in their entirety and substitute in lieu thereof the following:

(b) If Chattahoochee Hills initiates a complete revision of a substantial portion of the zoning code or the zoning districts or if Chattahoochee Hills initiates a request for a rezoning on more than six tracts of land to be heard and considered at the same time, then the Department shall give notice by regular mail to all property owners, as they appear on the tax records of Chattahoochee Hills as retrieved by the County's Geographic Information System, whose property lies within the city limits of Chattahoochee Hills.

The published and mailed notices shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, a statement that the hearing concerns revisions of a substantial portion of the zoning code or zoning districts, and where to access a map showing the proposed zoning. Mailed notices shall also contain the address and parcel ID of the parcel owned by the recipient.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
