



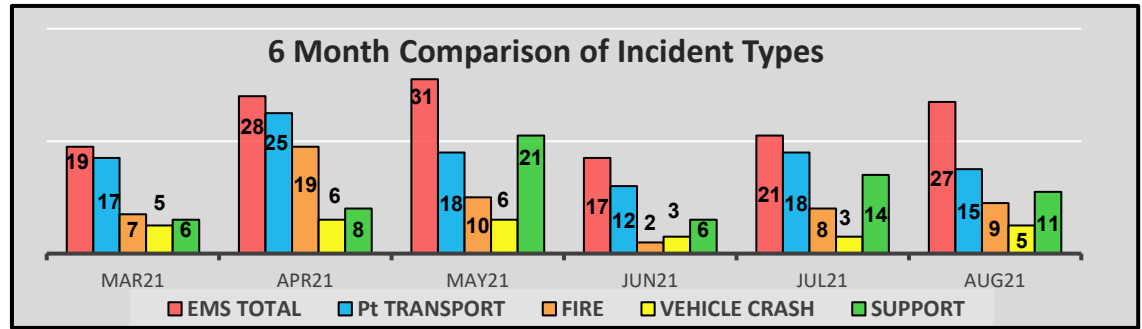

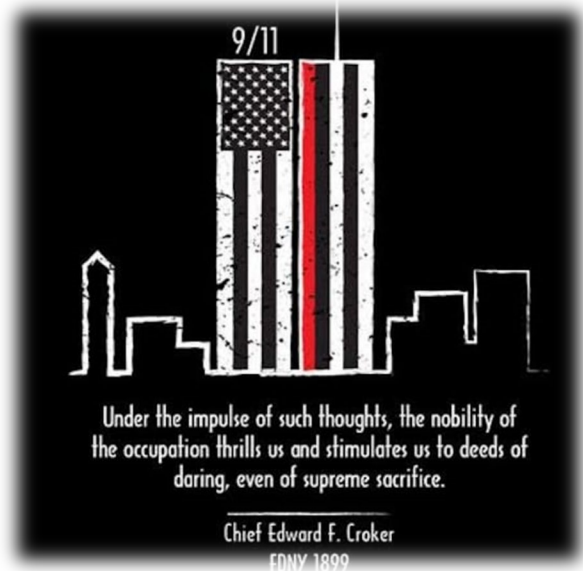
Remembering 9-11 ... Twenty Years

The “thin red line” is often overlooked, yet its simple design is an enduring salute to firefighters who die in the line of duty. **Simple ... Bold**—the two words are sharply contrasted but they demonstrate what firefighter resolve is about. Get the job done--SIMPLE; no matter the job or circumstance—BOLD.

Twenty years ago a horrible act was perpetrated on the American people—the attacks on the World Trade Center and Pentagon set in motion events resulting in nearly 3,000 deaths to-date. Firefighters from New York, and eventually other jurisdictions, were a part of the initial response, and thus many firefighters perished on that day and since from associated maladies.

Lately firefighters have seen their ranks depleted by another horror—the COVID pandemic. Just as they did on September 11, 2001, firefighters continue to embrace danger and possible death. And so, we wear the thin red line.

The red line signifies a blood-line of selfless workers who give ... and give ... and sometimes pay a big price. These Firefighter-EMTs have dedicated their lives to serving others ... in all ways and at all times. It is a simple, bold “calling,” a thin red line we walk.
