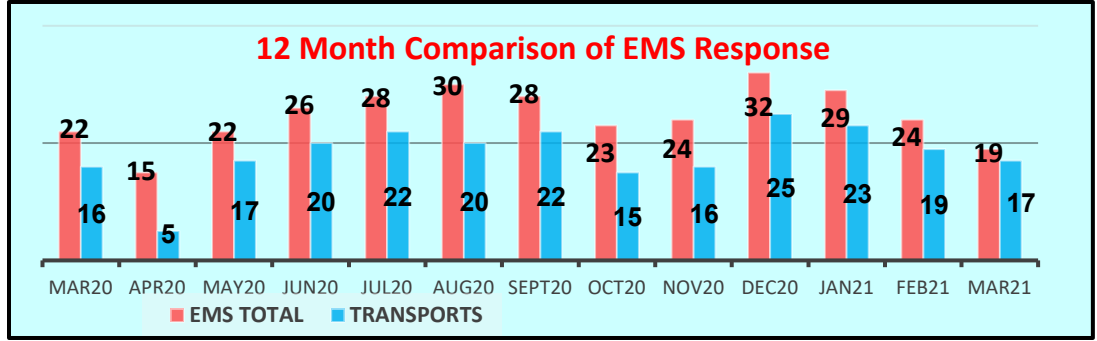

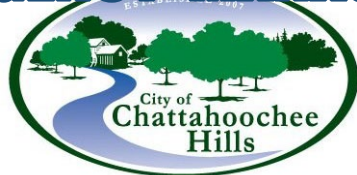

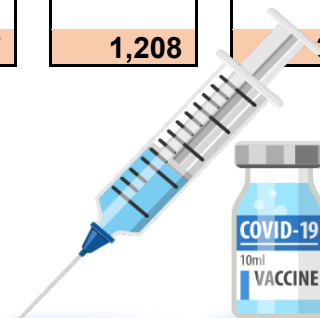

## Newnan/Coweta Tornado Frightening

### SNAPSHOT – March 25

**23:11 hrs:** Issued TORNADO WARNING via *Chatt Hills Alerts*

**23:45 hrs:** On phone with Palmetto Fire Chief to advise immediate danger from tornado on ground near Newnan and traveling northeast

### SNAPSHOT – March 26

**00:15 hrs:** On phone with Fulton Dispatch relaying calls into Newnan and Coweta Fire Dept field crews... Newnan/Coweta dispatching/radio services OUT!

**00:45 hrs:** On phone with Palmetto and Fairburn Chiefs organizing "task force" response to assist Newnan/Coweta

**02:00 hrs:** En route to Newnan/Coweta with crews and equipment

**03:00 hrs:** Cutting with chainsaws near downtown Newnan

**08:00 hrs:** In Emergency Operations Center defining response/recovery plan with GEMA and Coweta (x2 days)
